## How to use the card game

The Craft Your Future ideation card game can be used as a stand-alone activity to enrich your design and brainstorming work by bringing in elements of craft, tech and circularity. However, it's also designed to be the final stage of our Craft Your Future student programme for VET students. There are four types of card: craft cards, tech and trend cards, circular economy cards and wildcards. Each of these helps to bring new elements into your design.

There's an instruction sheet included with each pack of cards - follow these instructions and keep the sheet to use again. You can use post-it notes to add things onto your instruction sheet as your work on your ideas.

## Extra inspiration from our knowledge base

To help get the ideas flowing, we've also created a knowledge base with short online videos about each of the cards. On the instruction sheet included with the cards there's a QR code which will take you to the knowledge base. These 1-minute mini-introductions to each of the crafts, tech and circular economy principles can help you out if you draw a card you're completely stuck on!
