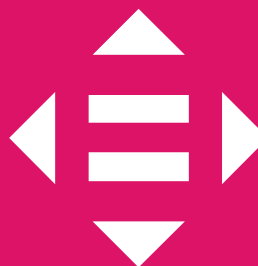

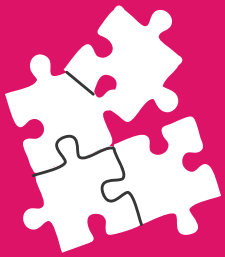

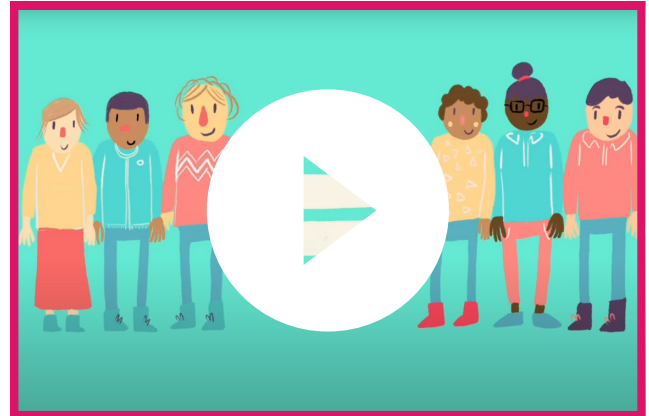

Did you know?



In recent years, global wealth distribution has remained markedly unequal. A considerable portion of the world's wealth is concentrated in the hands of the wealthiest 1% of the population, leading to disparities in living standards and opportunities among different socioeconomic groups.

Income inequality is widespread in numerous countries, with a significant portion of the population encountering economic hardships, limited access to quality education, and diminished prospects for upward mobility due to income gaps.



SDG 10 also tackles discrimination and marginalization rooted in factors like gender, race, ethnicity, and socioeconomic status. In many societies, systemic biases lead to unequal treatment and opportunities for various groups of people.

A Day In The Life Of A Trans Woman

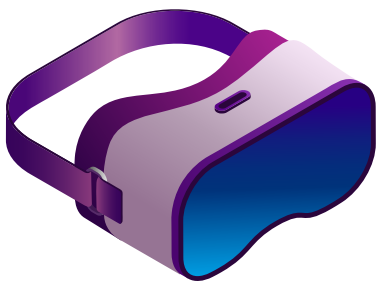
