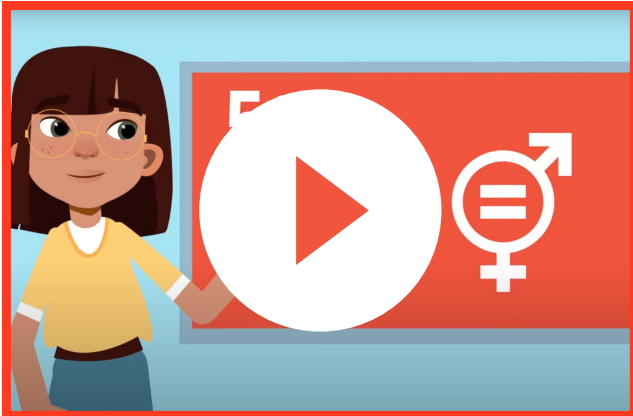
Questions

- In what ways are individuals and organizations globally working towards achieving gender equality, and what progress has been made in reducing the gender gap in areas like pay, leadership, and representation in government?





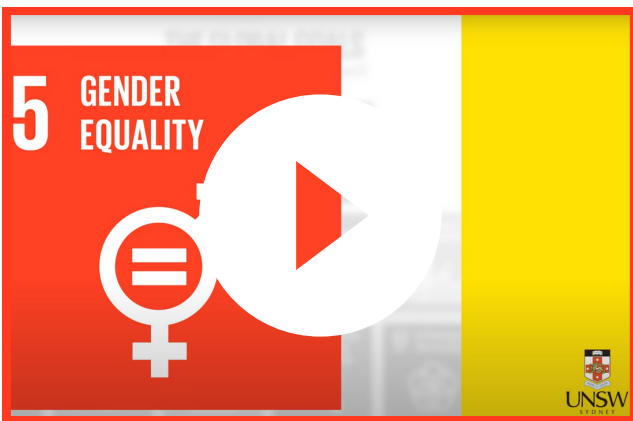

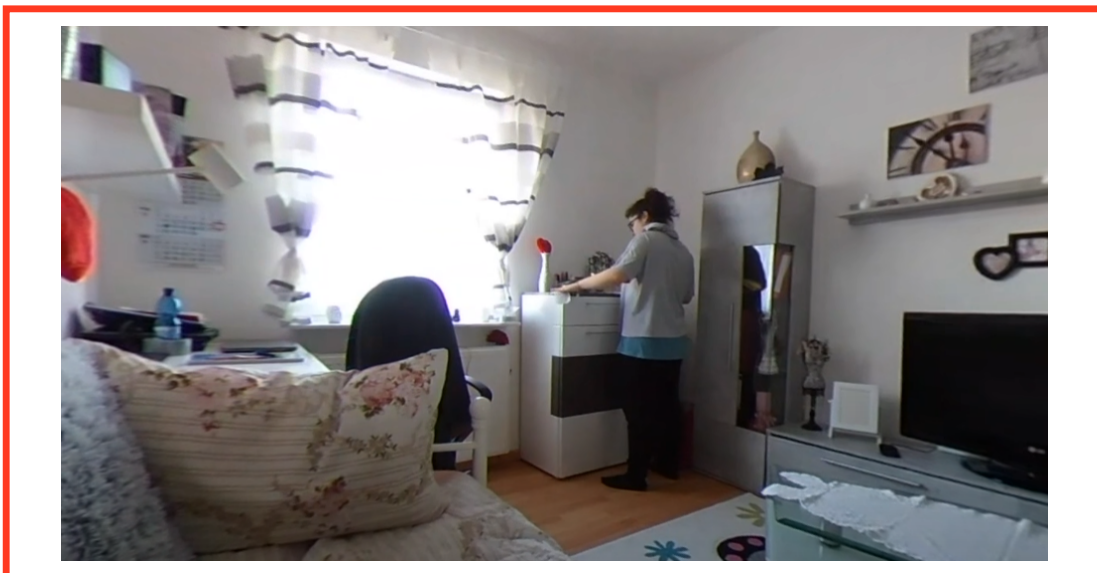

My World 360°

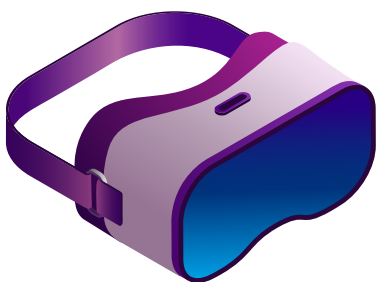
